

COLLEGE HISTORY

Established in 1878 by the Church Missionary Society of England with the lofty aim of imparting value based education leading to the holistic development of the personality of the students, St. John's College caters to the needs of students from all sections of the society.

St. John's College is an Aided First Grade Post Graduate and Research Institution affiliated to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. The 137 year old St. John's College has well-qualified and dedicated staff, spacious class rooms, well-equipped Laboratories, library and Computer Centre with internet access, stately buildings and protected water supply in a sprawling campus. The NSS, NCC, YRC, Placement Cell and other Associations provide activities that develop the creative and innovative potentials of students. Having the moto, "From Darkness Lead Us Unto Light" the college strives for the total enlightenment of the students, offering an ambience of freedom, fenced with the right level of discipline.

There are hostels for men students and women students in separate campuses.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application Forms can be obtained from the College office. The cost of the application form for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. courses is Rs.50/-, for Post Graduate courses is Rs.100/-, and for the M.Phil courses, Rs.150/-. Filled in applications must be submitted to the Principal either in person or by post before the last date. The last date for receipt of completed applications will be notified on the College notice board. However, students are advised to submit their filled in application forms within 10 working days from the date of the release of the 12th Standard results.

Both men and women candidates may apply for all UG and PG courses.

NOTE

For PG Admission, students can apply with the mark statement of the first five semesters, if they do not have the VI semester results. However the selected students should produce the statement of marks for semester VI, as soon as it is released.

The list of provisionally selected candidates will be displayed on the College notice board. The candidates will have to appear for a personal interview along with their parents/legal guardians. The following certificates must be produced in original at the time of the interview:

- Certificate of Educational Qualification
- Conduct Certificate
- > Transfer Certificate
- Community Certificate
- > Family Card
- ➤ Passport size photos –5nos.[Size: 45mm x 35mm with white backround]

The selected candidates must be prepared to pay the fees immediately. Failure of the provisionally selected students to appear for the interview or to pay the fee within two days from the date of interview will result in the cancellation of their selection.

As the original Transfer Certificate and the Statement of marks will not be returned to the admitted candidates, they are advised to retain sufficient number of attested photo copies of the same before submitting the originals at the office. Admission is subject to verification of mark certificates by the Director of Government Examination and if the mark certificate is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation besides criminal action being taken. The incomplete applications and the applications received after the deadline will be rejected.

OUR CURRICULUM - CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM [CBCS]

The College follows the Choice Based Credit System [CBCS] with a variety of choices to the learners according to their aptitude and competence. Students must earn a minimum of 140 credits to get UG Degree, 90 credits to get PG Degree.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The College offers many Co-curricular and Extra – curricular programmes. Students, after getting admitted into the College, will have to join any one of the following available programmes.

Students Service Activities, NCC, NSS, Sports and Games, Nature Club, Citizens Consumer's Club, Career Guidance Cell, Forum for Women Students and Youth Red Ribbon Club (YRRC). Four credits are allotted to NCC as per the University norms.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Merit, Community, Military, Physically Challenged, National Loan Scholarships and Full/Half fee concession under Tamil Nadu Education Rules are available to the Students. Student's Aid Scheme renders financial assistance to the needy students. Application forms to avail such scholarships can be obtained from the office, when announced.

OUR HOSTELS

For Boys

St. Paul's Hostel situated in the College campus, accommodates only male students who need hostel accommodation.

For Girls

Sharon Hall is the hostel for the women students.

After getting admission into the College, students must apply separately for admission to the hostels. Application froms can be obtained from the College Management Office.

[No Capitation fee is demanded for any course]

[There is no tuition fee for UG Courses]

Incomplete Application Forms are liable to be rejected. The admitting authority has the right to reject any Application without assigning any reason. Parents/Guardians are advised to call on the Head of the Department/Staff Adviser/Principal at least twice a Semester, to keep themselves informed of the academic progress, conduct and attendance of their children/wards. They are also requested to make all payments on time.

Admitted students should adhere to the rules and regulations of the college.

To The Kind Attention of Students and Parents:

- Smoking and use of tobacco are strictly forbidden in the College and Hostel premises.
- The use of alcohol and narcotic drugs is strictly prohibited. Any student found using or having used liquor/drugs or any other intoxicants will be summarily dismissed from the College.
- Ragging in any form is a serious offence and those indulging in it will be summarily dismissed.
- Students who
 - > are guilty of rude language towards the staff by the follow students of the college or hostels
 - assault or attempt to assault staff or fellow students of the College or hostels will be severely dealt with as per the educational rules of the Tamil Nadu Government [1978]. [If proved guilty, he/she will be dismissed from the College].
- Possession or use of camera mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- Regular attendance at all classes is insisted upon in this college.
- Students without ID Cards shall not be permitted to enter into College/Hostel Campus.
- Students ID card should be worn by the students in the campus, throughout College hours.

- Fee once paid will not be refunded on any account.
- All students must wear the uniform prescribed by the College. except Examination Days, Annual Day, Graduation Day, Sports Day and other days of College Functions. However colour dress can be worn on Saturdays.
- Students should not wear T. Shirts.

PLEASE NOTE: Asking, receiving and giving bribe for admission is an offence, complaints about bribe for admission should be brought to the notice of the Principal immediately.
