ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

St. John's College, Palayamkottai, established in 1878, by Church Missionary Society, England at Palayamkottai, in Tamilnadu, is a major College imparting higher education in the fields of Arts and Science. The College is one of the first four oldest Colleges in the undivided Madras State. A small and unpretentious Anglo-vernacular School established by the Church Missionary Society in 1844 in a hired house at Palayamkottai was the tiny seed from which grew the magnificent St. John's College. This Government Aided College was affiliated with Madurai Kamaraj University previously and since 1990 affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. It has also been recognized by the UGC under section 2(F) and 12(B) in 1956 to receive institutional grants. The College has now completed 143 years of service in the cause of higher education with the status of a first grade postgraduate Institution, fulfilling the vision of its founder, the Rev. Schafter. This has become possible entirely due to the prayers, devotion, zeal and tireless service of the Church Missionaries.

The College has 10 UG courses, 5 PG courses, 1 M.Phil. programme under aided stream and has 10 UG courses, 7 PG courses, 5 M.Phil. programme under un-aided stream. Also 8 departments have been upgraded as Research Centres and actively doing their research with more than 164 scholars under 53 recognised research supervisors.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Mathematics of St. John's College is as old as the College itself and it has the unique honour of having had scholars like Dr. R.P. Burn from England, and Dr. S. Arumugam. At first Mathematics was offered as an optional paper for intermediate courses. In 1945, taking into account the growing demand to study Mathematics, B.Sc., Mathematics was introduced under the affiliation of Madras University and then came under the Madurai Kamaraj University in early days. M.Sc. Mathematics was introduced in 1967, when the renowned thinker, Dr.R.P.Burn was heading the Department. St. John's was the first college in the southern districts and was the third College in the Madurai University to offer M.Sc., degree in Mathematics.

In 2008, M.Phil. Mathematics was introduced. In 2017, both UG and PG Mathematics courses were started under self-financing schemes. It has been upgraded into Research Centre in 2017. It has a set of 18 qualified faculty members under aided and self-financing schemes; 16 research scholars are now doing their research in a variety of areas.

After getting the notification of acceptance, Authors are instructed to fill the registration form and then they will be eligible to present their paper in RTMM-2021.

After completing the presentation in RTMM-2021, Authors are requested to submit their full paper, either in word or in LaTeX format, to the email id maths@stjohnscollege.edu.in. The full paper should be modified by considering the suggestions/corrections given by the resource person(s) / participant(s) at the time of presentation. The template of the full paper will be sent to your registered e-mail id.
